

2008 OSCA MINIMUM BASE-FINE SUMMARY (MBFS-08)

SCHEDULE OF MINIMUM BASE-FINE AMOUNTS FOR VIOLATION OFFENSES IN OREGON AS OF JANUARY 1, 2008

Source: The Office of the State Court Administrator (OSCA) provides MBFS-08 pursuant to ORS 153.138.

Effective Date: January 1, 2008, for offenses committed on and after January 1, 2008. **NOTE:** The increased county assessment amounts apply to judgments entered on or after January 1, 2008, regardless of the date of the offense.

Purpose: MBFS-08 summarizes **minimum amounts that the citing enforcement officer must enter on the citation in the place designated for "base fine"** when charging a person with a violation-level offense, including those created by city or county ordinance. See ORS 153.008. The base fine is not the maximum fine a court can impose. It is the fine amount the defendant can pay to resolve the violation offense without having to do anything else, unless the court requires the defendant to appear. See ORS 153.061. The court can impose a higher fine, up to the maximum statutory sanction, if the court requires the defendant to appear.

Effect on Previous Summary: The immediate previous summary to MBFS-08 is MBFS-06, released December 2005 and effective January 1, 2006. MBFS-08 supersedes all previous base-fine summaries for violations (including former summaries using terms like "bail schedule" or "infractions"). Previous summaries are available online (see below).

Attached Worksheets: MBFS-08 includes the worksheets that compute the base fines. **Citing officers do not need the worksheets** to know what to write on a citation. The worksheets show the amounts of the various component monetary obligations in the base fine. Courts can use the worksheets to adjust sanctions and properly disburse moneys. The worksheets show any formula used in a computed field and the statutory maximum and minimum money sanctions that courts may impose for specific violations.

Law Changes Reflected: This summary includes the following 2007 substantive legislative changes:

- Eliminating January 1, 2008, sunset on law that doubles fines for traffic offenses committed in safety corridors, Or Laws 2007 ch 653, §2 (HB 2274);
- Increased penalties for offense of careless driving contributing to an accident (ORS 811.135) that results in injury or death of a vulnerable user; substantial increase in potential penalty and in base fine to encourage "nonstatutory diversion"; requires citing officer to note on UTC that defendant must appear as for a misdemeanor (revised UTC will include), Or Laws 2007, ch 784, §3 (HB 3314);
- New Class A traffic violation for violating maximum weight limits when eligible for a variance permit; amending ORS 818.020(4), Or Laws 2007, ch 380, §1 (HB 2902);
- New Class A traffic violation for violation of variance permit; amending ORS 818.340, Or Laws 2007, ch 664, §2 (HB 2936);
- New Class C traffic violation for failure to remove vehicle from highway after accident, Or Laws 2007, ch 664, §4 (HB 2936);
- New Class A violation if MIP operating a motor vehicle; amendment to ORS 471.430, OR Laws 2007, ch 41, §1 (HB 2148);
- New Class C traffic violation for endangering a Class I all-terrain vehicle operator, OR Laws 2007, ch 887, §6 (SB 101); and
- New Class D traffic violation for person under 18 years of age operating a motor vehicle while using a mobile communication device, OR Laws 2007, ch 870, §2, (HB 2872).

Assessments Reflected: As with previous summaries, the amounts shown as "base fines" in MBFS-08 include the unitary assessment (UA) established by ORS 137.290 (UA) and the county assessment (CA) established by ORS 137.309 (CA). See ORS 153.125. UA and CA do not apply to parking offenses.

What Base Fines Are Not/Do Not Do: The base fines listed in MBFS-08

- are **not** security-release amounts, bail, or security-release deposit amounts; they do not affect security-release procedures under ORS 135.265
- do **not** include any moneys for restitution or costs
- do **not** apply to misdemeanors or felonies; Oregon statutory procedures for crimes do not use "base fines"

SECTION I - VIOLATION MINIMUM BASE-FINE AMOUNTS, by class with enhancements. <p>F. SPECIFIC-FINE VIOLATIONS. Specific-fine violations are punishable by a specific fine as the penalty. That specific fine is set in statute as a specific amount of money. The statute does not designate the offense as a misdemeanor or felony or as a Class A, B, C, or D violation and does not include a term of imprisonment as a penalty. The base-fine amount is the fine amount set by statute plus \$37 for the unitary assessment plus the appropriate county assessment amount under ORS 137.309. SECTION II - SPECIAL VIOLATIONS. Miscellaneous violations that have special provisions affecting how the base fine for the offense is determined. Not an exhaustive list.

A. **TRAFFIC, SPEEDING.** These speed violations (except 811.806, which is always a Class D violation) are subject to sanction and enhancements based on the speed driven in excess of the speed limits set in ORS 811.109.
SEE SECTION I FOR CITATION AMOUNTS, SPECIFIC SUBJECT SPEEDS INDICATED AT BEGINNING OF EACH CLASS OF VIOLATION.

The following statutes set speed limits:

- ORS 811.100, basic rule (varies with circumstances)
- ORS 811.111, includes speed violations from now-repealed ORS
 - rural interstate passenger vehicles; trucks and passenger transport (55 mph for subject vehicles)

SECTION V - CAUTIONS AND CAVEATS about how changes to laws, rules and ordinances can affect base fines.

1. **New and changing offense levels:** Each session, the legislature may create new violation-level offenses and change existing classification levels. It is not the purpose of this summary to include all new offenses or to track changes in classification levels of existing offenses.
2. **Changing base fines and sanction levels by rules and ordinances.** State agency rules and political subdivision rules and ordinances may establish various classes of lower violations (with lower base fines) where a statute provides for a single level of sanction “for any violation of any . . .” rule or ordinance. See ORS 153.022 and 153.025.
3. **Creating offenses by rules and ordinances.** A number of violation-level offenses can be created by state agency rule or by local government ordinance or rule. These offenses are subject to the same formulas used to calculate statutory base fines. See ORS 153.008 and 153.125. **Courts should deduct UA and CA moneys out for these violations before distributing fine moneys.** Although this summary does not list rules or ordinances that adopt a violation-level offense or statutes that grant this authority, worksheet Table 11 can help courts determine disposition of moneys in these cases.

NOTES AND WORKSHEETS USED FOR MBFS-08

A. GENERAL. The MBFS-08 uses a formula set by statute, ORS 153.125 to 153.145, to calculate base-fine amounts (except for fish and wildlife offenses, see Section IV of MBFS-08 above). ORS 153.538 requires that the Office of the State Court Administrator send out information from time to time that reflects the base-fine amounts as determined by the statutory formula.

The base-fine amounts shown in these worksheets and on the attached MBFS-08 are the amount an officer writes on the front of a citation when issuing the citation. They do not necessarily determine the amount that a court will impose as a final sanction or will require if the court requires a security release amount.

Amounts imposed as sanctions on conviction for an offense constitute a single assessment, see ORS 137.293.

B. LAW CHANGES REFLECTED. These worksheets show the calculations for the base-fine summary under statutes that take effect on January 1, 2008, and include changes resulting from 2007 legislation.

- Eliminating January 1, 2008, sunset on law that doubles fines for traffic offenses committed in safety corridors, Or Laws 2007 ch 653, §2 (HB 2274);
- Increased penalties for offense of careless driving contributing to an accident (ORS 811.135) that result in injury or death of a vulnerable user; substantial increase in potential penalty and in base fine to encourage “nonstatutory diversion”; requires citing officer to note on UTC that defendant must appear as for a misdemeanor (revised UTC will include), Or Laws 2007, ch 784, §3 (HB 3314);
- New Class A traffic violation for violating maximum weight limits when eligible for a variance permit; amending ORS 818.020(4), Or Laws 2007, ch 380, §1 (HB 2902);
- New Class A traffic violation for violation of variance permit; amending ORS 818.340, Or Laws 2007, ch 664, §2 (HB 2936);
- New Class C traffic violation for failure to remove vehicle from highway after accident, Or Laws 2007, ch 664, §4 (HB 2936);
- New Class A violation if MIP operating a motor vehicle; amendment to ORS 471.430, Or Laws 2007, ch 41, §1 (HB 2148);
- New Class C traffic violation for endangering a Class I all-terrain vehicle operator, Or Laws 2007, ch 887, §6 (SB 101); and
- New Class D traffic violation for person under 18 years of age operating a motor vehicle while using a mobile communication device, Or Laws 2007, ch 870, §2, (HB 2872).

C. THERE ARE NO BASE-FINE AMOUNTS FOR MISDEMEANORS AND FELONIES. Procedures for misdemeanor- and felony-level offenses are different from those for violation-level offenses. *See generally* ORS chapter 153. A base-fine amount is not a security release amount and cannot be posted as a preliminary appearance for a misdemeanor or felony.
