On January 12, 2012, the Supreme Court:

1. Allowed petitions for review in¹:

State of Oregon v. Leonard Lloyd Reinke (S059760) (A144138) (appeal from Multnomah County Circuit Court; opinion reported at 245 Or App 33, 260 P3d 820 (2011)).

Defendant Leonard Lloyd Reinke seeks review of a *per curiam* Court of Appeals decision that (among other things) affirmed a trial court's imposition of a "dangerous offender" sentence over defendant's objection that the requisite facts had not been pleaded.

On review, the issues are:

(1) Does the Oregon Constitution require the state to plead in the indictment facts necessary to find that defendant is a dangerous offender, before a sentencing court may impose a dangerous offender sentence?

(2) If not, is the state otherwise required to include them in some type of document that is filed with the trial court?
